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2011 SENIOR AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP OF QUEENSLAND

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. **1.1 THE CHAMPIONSHIP:** The Championship will be played over 54 holes of stroke play at Southport Golf Club - 18 holes on each of Monday 11th, Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th July 2011.
1.2 CLUB TEAMS EVENT: A Club Teams Event will be held in conjunction, teams comprising of four (4) players from the same club. The aggregate of the three (3) best scores from each day of the Championship will count towards the team's 54 hole total.
2. **CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE:** A Championship Committee, appointed by Golf Queensland, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or fix another day/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem it advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.
3. **ENTRIES:**
 - 3.1 The Championship is open to all male amateur golfers who have attained the age of 55 years, as at the 11th July 2011, with an Australian Men's Handicap **not exceeding 18.4 at the date of entry**, who are members of a golf club affiliated through their District Golf Association with Golf Queensland, or other State/National Associations.
 - 3.2 **The field will be limited to 170 players** - should entries be received in excess of this number the higher handicap players will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded.
 - 3.3 Entries must be received by Golf Queensland, GPO Box 1518, Brisbane Qld 4001, by 5:00pm on Friday 1st July 2011. Late entries may not be accepted. Inquiries can be made through the Golf Queensland office on (07) 3252 8155. A list of entries will be published on Golf Queensland's website – www.GolfQueensland.org.au.
 - 3.4 The prescribed Nomination Fee of \$80.00 (incl. GST) **must** accompany the nomination form at the time of nomination. Faxed entries will only be accepted if payment is made by credit card (and should be sent to 3257 1520) - telephone entries will not be accepted.
 - 3.5 Do not send cash in the mail - Golf Queensland will not accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received.
 - 3.6 Entries must be accompanied by either the player's *GOLFLink* number or a copy of his current handicap record officially endorsed by his Home Club.
 - 3.7 Nominations are accepted at face value, on the basis that information contained therein is correct, and up to date. Should this subsequently be proven not to be the case, Golf Queensland reserves the right to deem any competitor ineligible – at any time prior to or during the Championship.
 - 3.8 Once the draw is completed there will be no refund of entry fees for players who withdraw from the event. Players who withdraw prior to the qualifying round draw being published will be refunded their entry fee, less an administration fee of \$11.00.
4. **PUBLICITY:** Golf Queensland arranges publicity before, during and/or after this Championship. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them, and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet).
5. **PRIVACY:** Golf Queensland may retain the personal details (i.e. name, address, handicap) of entrants in this Championship on its records. The purpose of doing so is such that information on other future events conducted by Golf Queensland (or other parties) can be forwarded as deemed appropriate by Golf Queensland. This information will not be available to any other organisation. Any person may have their details removed from this database by phoning Golf Queensland on (07) 3252 8155.
6. **HONORARY MEMBERS:** Competitors will be made honorary members of Southport Golf Club for the duration of the Championship.
7. **DRESS REGULATIONS:** It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply with the dress regulations of the host club.
8. **PRACTICE:** Scheduled practise day **Sunday 10th July- 6:30am to 8:15am** 1st and 10th tees at Southport Golf Club will be available, Please book with The Proshop – (07) 5571-1444.
9. **RULES:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply, together with the Golf Australia Hard Card, and additional Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.
10. **COURSE MARKERS:** During practice or during the Championship a player shall not place on the course, or cause to be placed on the course, any artificial marker or other device designed to indicate course measurements. A player in breach of this condition shall be disqualified.

11. **DRAW AND STARTING TIMES:** A draw for each day's play will be published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Committee. Rule 6-3a provides "The player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole, instead of disqualification.
12. **BALL:** It will be obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current list of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A Rules Limited. PENALTY: Disqualification.
13. **DRIVER HEADS:** Any driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by the R&A. PENALTY: Disqualification.
14. **USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES:** Players may use motorised buggies in this Championship.
15. **MOBILE PHONES:** The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during the play of any competition round is prohibited. Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.
16. **PACE OF PLAY:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. A Pace of Play Schedule and description of applicable penalties for breaching this schedule will be supplied to competitors prior to the first round of the tournament.
17. **DRUG TESTING:** All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Doping Policy - endorsed by Golf Queensland Inc. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.
18. **TIES:** In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee determines otherwise, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with other or others until the winner is determined. All other ties will be decided by the Australian Countback System.
19. **PROTESTS:** Protests must be lodged in writing with the Championship Committee no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round on each day.
20. **TROPHIES:** Trophies will be awarded to the Championship winner and runner-up, and to the winners of the following categories:- 55-59 years, 60-64 years, 65-69 years and 70 years and over (a minimum of six competitors is required in each category to qualify for a trophy). The overall 54 hole nett winner and runner-up, as well as the player with the best nett score in each age division will also receive trophies. The overall 54 hole Team Winners. Trophies will be limited to one per person.
