Play will commence from the 1st and 10<sup>th</sup> tees beginning with the qualifying players with the highest stroke scores and concluding with players with the lowest stroke scores (i.e. leaders).

## - REGISTRATION

Players are requested to report to the registration desk in the clubhouse to receive scorecards, local rules and course maps. Players are requested to report to the starter at the appropriate tee **NO LATER THAN 10 MINUTES** prior to tee time.

## - SCORE CARDS

All score cards are to be returned to the score board situated in the North end of the Club House.

## - PRACTICE

Competitors will be permitted to practice on the Championship course on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October subject to booking the round with the Pro-shop and upon payment of a green fee. A reduced fee of \$25.00 will include a bucket of range balls has been arranged with the Club. Players must not practice from the plates.

## - DRESS REGULATIONS

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Host Clubs' dress regulations with particular reference to the following: -

- ❖ Clean dress shoes **MUST** be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- ❖ Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- ❖ All shirts must have a collar.
- ❖ Tailored shorts are permitted. Gentlemen must wear long socks or white short socks with such shorts.
- ❖ Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

## - CLUB COURSE REGULATIONS

Sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used by each player. Play will be from the tee markers as directed by the starter. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with Golf Victoria's Code of Conduct.

## - SLOW PLAY

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

## - SUSPENSION OF PLAY

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play.

The signal for suspending play will be three short siren blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

## LUNCHESES

During all rounds of the Championship, meal vouchers will be given out by Golf Victoria Officials. The vouchers may then be exchanged in the clubhouse for a meal. **Meals will be available from 11.00am to 2.30pm.** Players will only be able to utilise their meal vouchers during this time.

### - TRI-STATE SENIOR TEAMS CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2011 Tri-State Senior Teams Championship will be played concurrently with the 2011 Victorian Senior Amateur Championship. Teams consisting of seven male amateur players will represent Victoria, Queensland and New South Wales.

A player will be eligible to only represent the State that his home club is affiliated with, irrespective of his permanent place of residence. The teams will be selected by their respective State Golf Body and submitted to the Host State prior to the first day of the Championship.

For each round of the Championship, the lowest five stroke scores from each team of seven players shall count as the team score. The team with the lowest aggregate stroke score from all rounds of the Championship will be the Tri-State Senior Team Champions.

In the event of a tie for the Tri-State Senior Teams Championship, it shall be decided by count-back on the basis of the final round team score.
